

'Communication and Language: Supporting Pupils with Special Educational Needs (Primary)

Course Description

This course is for teachers working with students that have an assessed language and communication need.

Expected Outcomes

Participants will:

- Gain essential information on the nature and impact of language and communication needs.
- Develop a deeper understanding of language and communication.
- Consider the challenges / difficulties that pupils with special educational needs encounter vis-à-vis the development of language and communication skills.
- View assessment of language and communication as an integral part of the teaching and learning process.
- Consider collaborative approaches to meeting the needs of pupils with language and communication difficulties.
- Explore practical strategies to support pupils with language and communication needs access the curriculum.

Course Content

Overview of Language and Communication: Development of language and communication skills, language delay versus disorder, terminology associated with language and communication.

Outline of Challenges: Difficulties that pupils with special educational needs encounter vis-à-vis the development of language skills.

Assessment Practices / Workshop: Focused and relevant assessment to identify pupils' instructional needs.

Learning and Teaching Strategies: Practical learning and teaching strategies and purposeful instructional strategies that directly address the areas of need revealed through assessment.

Resources: Websites and books; a display of classroom resources.
