This one day seminar, for Primary and Post-Primary teachers, provides an overview of individualised educational planning with particular focus on planning for the pupil with Autism.

Anticipated Outcomes

Participants will:

- Develop an understanding of the IEP within the context of rationale, process and product
- Focus on the challenges for pupils with Autism in relation to inclusion and accessing the curriculum
- Explore the various stages of developing an IEP, beginning with gathering information and assessment
- Participate in workshops to identify pupils' strengths and needs, priority learning needs and targets
- Discuss strategies for IEP implementation and IEP review in collaborative settings

Course Outline and Content

- Explore the IEP rationale, process and product
- Outline the particular challenges experienced by pupils with Autism
- Focus on the unique learning style of the pupil with Autism
- Provide a framework for writing IEPs which includes the pupils' strengths and needs, priority learning needs, learning targets and progress

The course has three parts:

Part 1

- Why do we use IEPs and who are they for?
- School Self Evaluation and the Literacy and Numeracy Strategy- relevant DES and NSCE publications and guidelines
- The contents of an IEP
- IEP as an ongoing process

Part 2

- Background to Autism and challenges to the pupil
- Writing the IEP
- Autism specific assessment and assessment for Literacy and Numeracy
- Collaboration

Part 3

- Stages for writing the IEP
- Implementation and review
- Transition IEPs

Workshops are provided throughout the day to enable discussion and collaboration
