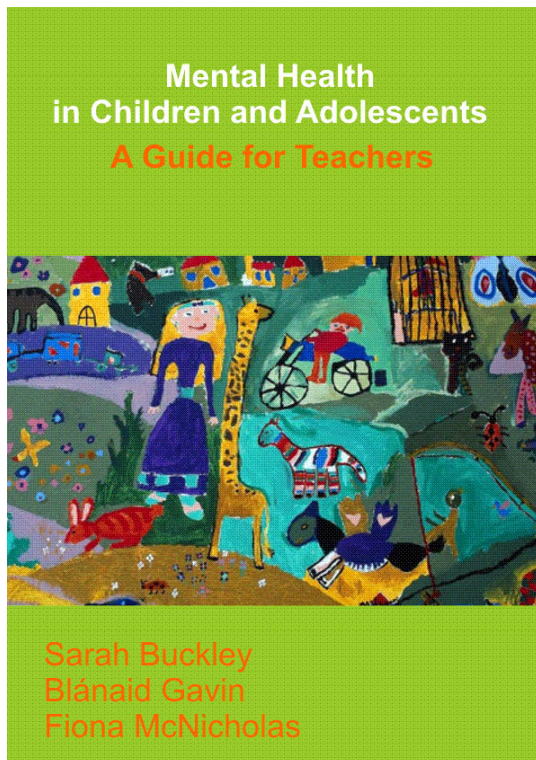




## Mental Health in Children and Adolescents: A Guide for Teachers
