Dyslexia Association of Ireland		A very detailed website with explanations of dyslexia, with advice and a list of courses on Dyslexia for teachers.
Dyslexia in Ireland		This is a website designed by a parent of a child with dyslexia. It also refers to dyscalculia.
The Reading Association of Ireland		Founded in 1975, it is affiliated to the International Reading Association, a body with over 100,000 members throughout the world, whose aim is to promote literacy worldwide. The association is run on a voluntary basis by its members.
